We have been, and will continue to be, vigilant with infection control protective measures for all residents and staff encourage social distancing and frequent handwashing to control the impact in these homes. Our group homes are like family, and we all share concern about each other during this time. Our hearts and prayers are with the affected residents and staff members and their family.
